Parental Contact

Two-way communication means you should feel free to get in touch with the school as you feel the need. The School Administration is in the office each day from 8:30am to 2:30pm (Monday to Friday). If no one is available to take your call, please leave a message and a staff member will return your call as soon as possible.

General questions should be addressed to the school administrative assistant. Questions concerning student progress/ behavior/social development should first be addressed to the child's teacher. If further information and/or clarification is required, the principal may be contacted.

In the rare event that your concerns cannot be worked out with school personnel, you should use the "Parental Concern Referral Form" and your concern will go on to the Family of Schools Supervisor or the Coordinator of Transportation. A copy of this form is available in the office or on the Board website.

Communication

Formal communication from the school is intended to inform you of your child's learning progress, social development, and school life in general. This communication may be through report cards, SSE Website, Facebook pages and School Messenger as well as monthly newsletters, and teacher communication plans. Parent/teacher visitations, E-mail, PowerSchool and the annual school reports are also means of our communication plan.

Specific needs may require the use of a specialized form such as, Emergency Allergy Alert forms, Authorization for Administration of Medication forms, Parental Concern Referral Forms and Registration forms. These are available upon request from the office.

Informal communication occurs as necessary. It may be a telephone call, a note from the teacher or school, a classroom activities up-date letter, a notice, an email, a reading log, or a comment in the homework planner or communication book.
